bearing westerly to the centre of Lang street; then again northerly to the Parramatta road; then easterly to Iron Cove bridge; then bounded by the waters of the Parramatta river to Long Cove creek, Leichhardt; then by a line on the west side of Long Cove creek, Petersham, bearing southerly up Long Cove creek to the point of commencement.
